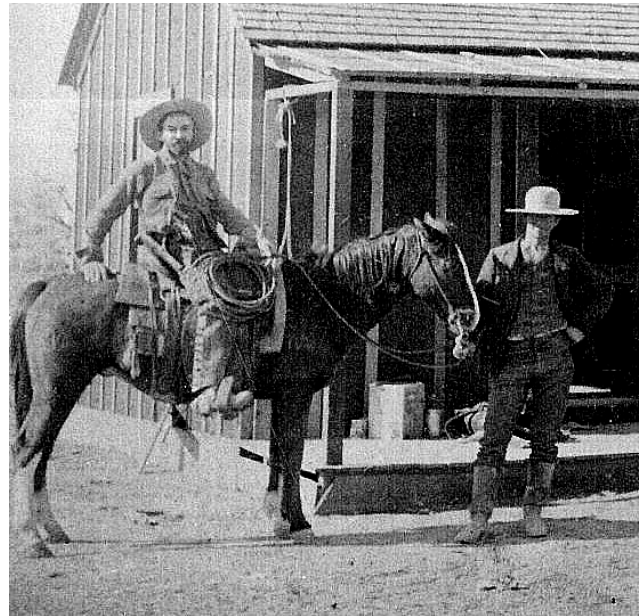

How to find us:

From I-5 take Exit 95, go West to Littlerock and turn left at the Chevron Station. Drive South 1.5 miles to the club entrance on your left.

Event Schedule:

Saturday: Mandatory shooter's meeting at **9:00 am**. 6-stage main match 9:30 am – 3:00 pm
Long Range Side Match 3:15 – 6:00 pm. Long Range Awards 6:00 p.m. Potluck 6:00 – 8:00 pm

Sunday: Flag salute at **9:00 am**. 6-stage main match 9:15 am – 3:00 pm
Man-on-man side match 3:00 pm – 4:00 pm Main Match Awards Ceremony – 4:15 pm

Main Match Round Count:

130 Pistol, 130 Rifle, and 70 shotgun should see you through.

Side Match Round Counts:

Long Range: 10 rounds per category for score, plus extra for sight-in.

Man-on-Man: This is a single elimination event, you will need 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun per turn.

Camping:

Club gates will be open at Noon on Friday, May 22.

Campers will be accommodated on the club house lawn – there is lots of room. Check in with the camp hosts -- Short Schatz and Wil Sackett.

- Dry camping only – hook ups are not available. Tents are welcome.
- The club grounds will be open to other club members during our event. Shooting hours are 8 am to 8 pm. Visitors must be accompanied by a club member for other than event shooting.
- A trailer will be available to shuttle shooters between the club house and the Cowboy Range on Saturday and Sunday.
- Pets must be on a leash or confined at all times. Clean up after your pet or don't bring it!
- Use of alcoholic beverages is permitted at the club only after shooting hours (8 PM) and all firearms are put away.
