

NORTHEAST WASHINGTON REGULATOR
LONG RANGE SHOOTING DAY
APRIL 30, 2009

Enjoy a full day of long range shooting at the Crown Creek Western Town and Saloon 40 miles north of Colville, WA (see attached map).

We will be offering three shoots. You may shoot one, two, or all three.

First Shoot: Pistol caliber rifle long range shoot consists of three targets; one each at 50 yards, 100 yards and 150 yards. Five shots at each target. Lead bullets only, any powder.

Second Shoot: Rifle caliber lever action long range shoot consists of three targets; one each at 100 yards off-hand, 150 yards shot from cross sticks, and 200 yards shot from cross sticks. Five shots at each target. Rifles must be lever action, of a type and caliber that would have been available and in common use before 1900; i.e., Winchester '76, '86, '94, '95 or similar Marlins, Savage 99's, etc. Lead bullets only, any powder, no scopes. Bring your cross sticks, shoot sitting or prone.

Third Shoot: Buffalo Rifle Gong shoot consists of three targets; one each at 250 yards, 435 yards and 525 yards. Five shots at each target for score. All shooting from cross sticks. Rifles must be of a type used during the buffalo hunts of the 1860's, 1870's and 1880's (Sharps, Rolling Blocks, Trapdoors, Ballards, etc.) Lead bullets only, any safe powder charge, black or smokeless.

Lunch and refreshments will be available at the range.

Time permitting, there will be an off-hand shoot at the Quigley bucket at 435 yards. For a special award, this is a 2-shot match.

Also, time permitting, there will be a long range shooting video presented in the Town theater.
